AMP Power Protection are committed to the prevention of pollution and continual improvement of our environmental performance. This has been facilitated through setting environmental objectives based on our environmental aspects. To achieve this goal, we have focussed on environmental issues, changed our working practices and processes to allow us to reduce our carbon footprint by setting clear goals, objectives, and putting measures in place that will allow us to reduce our impact on our environment.

AMP Power Protection have undertaken the following in Q3 2024:

- Continuous review of our Environmental Management System ISO14001
- Renewal of our ISO 14001 Certification
- Continuous review of our Environmental Aspects Register
- Take steps to prevent pollution to air, land and water.
- Lead by example in promoting environmental sustainability
- Implementing new procedures to help reduce our CO2 emissions; to achieve this goal we aim to reduce or consolidate our deliveries and volume of orders where possible and selecting transport companies that predominantly use electric vehicles.
- We continue to reduce our carbon footprint by adopting hybrid working for all staff reducing days in the office from 5 days to 3 days per working week.

Also, we work in partnership with our suppliers and customers to ensure our partnership also reduces carbon footprint, see below example.

The AMP Power Protection facility is based at Bucks-Biz iCentre in Newport Pagnell

Bucks Biz have instigated the below works to help reduce our carbon footprint and reduce environmental impact.

- The installation of energy efficient sensor lighting in all communal areas, that automatically turn off when not in use.
- LED lighting installed throughout the building.
- Provided new recycling facilities to reduce our waste.
- Installation of solar panels across the length of the building roof.
- Installation of EV Charging Stations to provide electrical power for recharging plug-in electric vehicles for staff and visitors to the site.
